**A**s the director of the organization, I am very pleased to share the details of the organization's activities and achievements for the year 2022-23 with all of you. We started our journey as a small youth brigade in a small village of Odisha and gave it a legal framework of society in the year 1993. Our team of dedicated workers are worked endlessly to make our vision a reality and is in a way quite successful in providing the intended services to lakhs of beneficiaries. In these years we have provided basic health care services to more than 5,00,000 population at their doorstep, and created many agricultural entrepreneurs and entrepreneurs in the village who are now earning a stable income from their enterprises.

The year 2022-23 was quite an interesting year for us as we created new friends, started new projects and were able to help new beneficiaries in new areas. Currently, we are working in three states Odisha, West Bengal and Jharkhand. The projects run in these states are chiefly on developing alternative livelihood and Health status of the community. In the year 2022-23, we have helped around 1048 people in developing alternative livelihoods and around 6000 people were provided with basic health services.

## Introduction.....

NAMM (National Association of Man from Mankind) started as a youth brigade in Chirulei village, Dhenkanal district of the state of Odisha and later it was given a legal framework of society. Since its inception in 1993, NAMM has worked for the development of impoverished and undeveloped communities of society. The main beneficiaries of NAMM are people belonging to tribal communities, Dalit communities, women and children. The main thematic areas of our work are health specifically on the health issues related to Livelihood generation, development of disaster resilience communities and women empowerment.

In recent years we have established ourselves as a multi-state agency but mostly confined ourselves within the tribal belts of eastern India. Our work areas are mainly focused on providing basic health care services, eradicating poverty through providing alternative livelihood activities to people, and empowering WSHGs by providing them income generation activities.

## What we do...(Thematic Areas of Intervention)

### Health and Nutrition

Health is a priority area of intervention for the "National Association of Man for Mankind". NAMM provides basic health care services and referral services to the rural tribal population. In the year 2022-23, the health projects of NAMM are being carried out in the Manoharopur block of the West singhbhum district of Jharkhand.

### Livelihood Generation

The livelihood of people of rural India is one of the major issues of concern for many years. Since our inception, we have been working for better alternative livelihood generation activities for the people of rural areas. We carry out training programs with the help of government and non-government organizations, facilitate the provision of necessary financial assistance to provide them with working capital to start the activity, help them introduce their products in the market and provide them knowledge on financial management. 1048 Family under the SFRUTI project.

### Women Empowerment

Women SHGs are now changing the economic scenario of rural areas through their efforts to create sustainable income-generation activities. With the help of TPCODL and OLM, we have employed 48 Wshgs members in Meter Reading and Bill Collection activity. Aware and sensitize people to disaster resilience.



### Skill Development

We are providing skill training to young adolescent boys and girls to clear competitive organizations and get employed in government and non-government organizations.

### Building Disaster Resilience Community

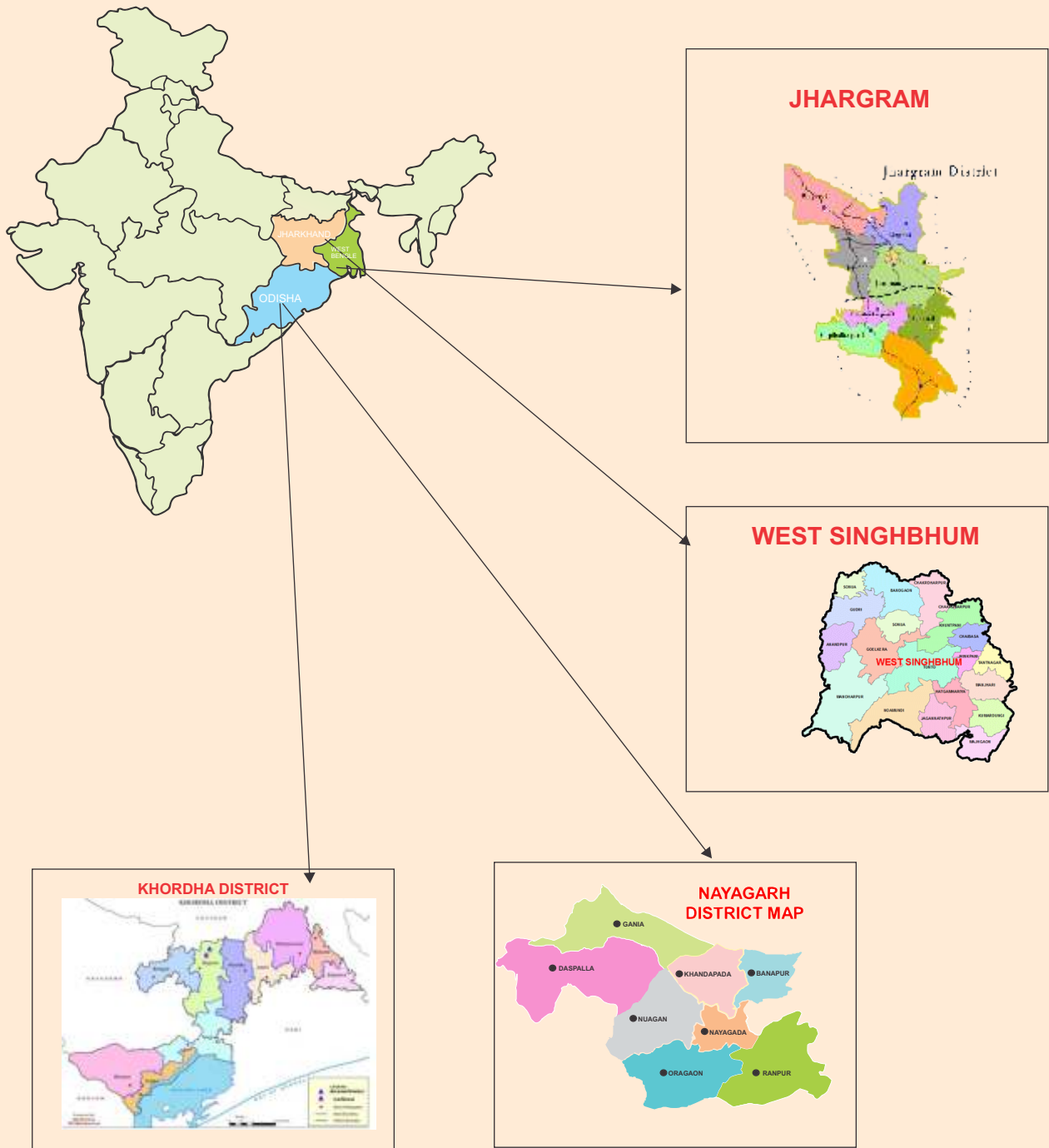
We are involved in the formation of disaster resilience communities. We have formed village disaster management plans (VDMP) in 92 villages of the Gondia, the Parjang and the Bhuban block of the Dhenkanal district. We carry out mock drills in the villages to aware and sensitize people to disaster resilience.





The health and Nutrition Program “Sanjeevani Clinic on Wheels” is being implemented in the Manoharpur block of West-Singhbhum district of Jharkhand. The Livelihood program “SFRUTI sponsored by MSME of GOI is implemented in the Manoharpur block of West -Singhbhum district of West Bengal-Jhargram. The Empowerment Program of NAMM supported by TPCODL is being implemented in the Tangi, Banapur, Chilika block of Khorda district and Ranapur of Nayagarh District of Odisha. The VDMP activity supported by OSDMA is implemented in the Dhenkanal district of Odisha. Along with this with the operational support of TPCDT, NAMM has also facilitated building of drinking water structures to provide clean drinking water to communities.









### Achievements:

This year was one of the most fantastic years if we look at the achievements of this year. Our staff and volunteers worked with enthusiasm and tirelessly to bring an affirmative change in society. This year we have carried out 880 health camps in which more than 6500 patients were treated. We carried out 473 awareness sessions in the project villages to make them aware of various prevalent health issues in the project area. We have trained members of 42 SHGs in meter reading, billing and bill collection activities and engaged in the same activity. We have carried out 150 awareness meetings, a study tour and 15 awareness camps with bamboo artisans in the Manoharpur block. We are also building a common facility center and a Workshop with modern equipment in the Sagjori village of the block. When fully implemented the project will provide sustainable income to 1048 bamboo artisans of the area.

## What we do...(Thematic Areas of Intervention)

### Health and Sanitation Project:

The health and Sanitation project is run under the banner of SBI Sanjivani Clinic on Wheels and is supported by the SBI Foundation. Under this project, we are running a Medical Mobile Unit. The Medical Mobile Unit is equipped with a pathology laboratory. A team of doctors, laboratory Assistants, Ambulance operators and pharmacists carry out the health camps in the village. The villages are informed about the time and place of the health camp beforehand by the health volunteers from the village. The health camps are generally conducted in the middle of the village where all the community members can come for medicine. The doctors not only prescribe medication they also give serious pieces of advice to keep them free from diseases. Apart from this, the team carries out health awareness activities in the village.

In the year 2022-23, we carried out 880 health camps where we treated around 6500 patients. We have also carried out around 473 awareness sessions where around 13000 people gathered and listened to various health-related information.

### Livelihood Generation Project:

The livelihood generation project is running in the Manoharpur block of the west singhbhum district of the Jharkhand state. NAMM is developing a Bamboo Craft Cluster in the block. NAMM under this project is building a Common facility centre with a work shed in Sagjori village of the block where modern machines will be installed in the work shed. The artisans will be given training on using the machines and product development. NAMM will also help the artisans in selling their products in the local, national and international markets. Fully Implemented the project will provide sustainable income to around 1047 artisans.



### Women Empowerment Project:

The Women Empowerment Project is running in the Balugaon electrical division of Odisha. Under this project, some members of the Wshg group were given training on meter reading and bill collection activity for electricity and then they were engaged in the MBC activity. We have provided training to 48 Wshgs and engaged them in the bill collection activity. Engaged women are earning a handsome amount of money staying in their own village. It was one of the most successful projects this year.





### **Skill Development Project:**

A skill development project is being implemented in the Chillika Block of the Khurda district. Under this project, youngsters are being trained to compete in different competitive exams so that they can get better jobs in the government and non-government sectors. Currently around 120 children are being provided training in this project.

Apart from this, NAMM also trains poor villagers in mushroom farming, goat farming and vegetable farming.



### **Disaster Management:**

A community can only be a disaster resilient community if it remains a tight-knit community and fights the effects of a natural or manmade disaster unitedly and with a proper plan. NAMM was given responsibility by the District Administration of Dhenkanal to carry out a village Disaster Management Plan in 92 villages of the Gondia, Bhuban and Parjang blocks of the district in 21-22. In 22-23, NAMM carried out mock drills and training camps in the cyclone shelters to train the community members on disaster preparedness.
